Colonel Price, ARNG, is the US Army National Guard Senior Policy Advisor to the Chairman of the Reserve Forces Policy Board (RFPB) in the Office of the Secretary of Defense, Washington, D.C. The Reserve Forces Policy Board serves as an independent adviser to the Secretary of Defense, providing advice and recommendations to the Secretary on strategies, policies, and practices designed to improve and enhance the capabilities, efficiency and effectiveness of the seven Reserve components.

Colonel Price (originally from Harrodsburg, KY) received his commission as an Engineer Officer through the Kentucky Army National Guard Officer Candidate School in 2002. He is a graduate of the Engineer Officer Basic Course, Engineer Captain's Career Course, Human Resources Management Qualification Course, Command and General Staff College and the United States Army War College.
