

## SERGEANT MAJOR JOSE AUGUSTO BANKS

Sergeant Major Jose A. Banks assumed responsibilities as the Senior Enlisted Advisor to the Reserve Forces Policy Board (RFPB), Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD), Washington, D.C., on March 3, 2025.

Born in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, Sergeant Major Banks enlisted in the U.S. Army Reserve on June 19, 1996, as a Human Resources Specialist (42A) and transitioned into the Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Program in November 2000.
