CAPT Timothy Trimble **Senior Policy Advisor, U.S. Navy Reserve**

CAPT Trimble is a native of Des Moines, Iowa and attended Boot Camp and STG A school in San Diego, CA. He served on the USS Reasoner (FF 1063) for close to five years before transitioning to reserves.

CAPT Trimble was commissioned as a Navy Reserve LDO designator 6125 in Oct 2002. In 2010, CAPT Trimble completed a mobilization to Manila, Philippines as the OIC of the SOCPAC detachment and in 2011, he reported to NRD Portland and served as an Officer Recruiter and Operations Officer.



In 2014, CAPT Trimble designated FTS HR designator 1207 and reported to NOSC Jacksonville as the N1. From May 2018 to Aug 2020, CAPT Trimble commanded NOSC Billings, MT. From Aug 2020 to Jan 2021, CAPT Trimble served as the N1 for Navy Region Southeast Reserve Component Command, Jacksonville. From Jan 2021 to June 2021, CAPT Trimble commanded NOSC Knoxville, TN.

In July 2021, CAPT Trimble reported to NTAG Jacksonville as the Executive Officer and as the Commanding Officer of NTAG Jacksonville from February 2023 to July 2024. CAPT Trimble then commanded RTAG Central from August 2024 to May 2026 and reported to the Reserve Forces Policy Board in June 2026 as the Senior Navy Reserve Policy Advisor.

CAPT Trimble graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree from Washington State University, MBA Degree from City University, JPME Phase 1 through the Naval War College and AJPME through the Joint Forces Staff College. CAPT Trimble holds the Professional in Human Resource (PHR) certification. CAPT Trimble's decorations include a Meritorious Service Medal (four awards), Joint Service Commendation Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (four awards) and Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (six awards).

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
