He is responsible for Federal and State missions. assignment of leaders, recruiting, training, equipping, mobilization, facilities, and public relations. He also oversees the development and coordination of

all policies, plans, and programs affecting Army and Air National Guard members in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. General Lamberton serves on the Governor's cabinet and is the principle advisor to the Governor on military matters.
